UPDATE ON BINGO POSITIONS

As I mentioned in my recent email, the countdown has started . . . assuming the snow SOMEDAY will quit, . . . it will be just a little more than four months until Holden, Lukwambe and Lauren will graduate!

Their graduation date is important to YOU not only because band students will play music at graduation, but also because upon graduation, these students and their folks (Diane Bradley, Latrell Rivers/Viola Dixon, Jean O'Daniel/Don Keach) will be leaving bingo work behind!

We had several wonderful, immediate responses to the email from people who are willing to become counter supervisors or assistants, as well as from a parent who is willing to try calling bingo. While I can't yet name these folks or definitely say which counter positions they'll be taking, they know who they are -- and I can say THANK YOU, THANK YOU, THANK YOU!!!

Meanwhile, we still have several vacancies that need to be filled as soon as possible:

- (a) Several **Pulltab Counter and/or Paper Counter positions;**
- (b) **Pulltab Scheduler to schedule/coordinate each week's pulltab sellers;**
- (c) **Counter Scheduler to schedule/coordinate each week's counter supervisors and assistants;** and
- (d) Several **more bingo callers to run the bingo games.**

You've heard, a hundred times before, that every band student at Henry Clay benefits from bingo, which is in line to raise over \$50,000 this year for band music, instructors, fees, etc.

You've also heard, dozens of times before, that the success of bingo turns largely on the enthusiastic participation of parents and students. For months, now, we've been asking -- begging -- parents to step up to take key positions as bingo callers and as counter workers.

While we made a great start with the initial response to the email, it's still not enough -- as you can see from the list above, we still have key positions which MUST be filled in order for bingo to keep operating.

SO -- my message to each freshman, sophomore and junior parent is -- it's time for you to decide whether you want bingo to continue as the band's primary fundraiser, keeping your out-of-pocket costs to a nominal amount compared to those of other area bands.

If you do, you need to step up within the next two weeks and contact me to say which position you are willing to fill. We need this kind of advance notice for two reasons: (1) so we can start training new people asap so they'll feel comfortable in their positions by the end of May; and (2) so if we don't get additional adult volunteers to take the regular, ongoing positions, we can follow an orderly process in shutting down the bingo program.

IT'S UP TO YOU. Those of us who are leaving want to see the bingo program continue, as we've worked very, very hard to make it into one of the best programs around. (Ask our customers!) If the program continues, we'll certainly support it as we can. However, after May we are not continuing in our present, key roles.

HC BAND "CHARMS" ONLINE SYSTEM

Charms Office Assistant is an online management system for bands and other organizations. Features for the HC Band program include: student profile information for directors; Booster organization tools; student areas for accessing calendar updates, music tools (i.e.: recording studio, assigned music, metronome, tuner, etc.), etc. The Charms online system is a very valuable communications & record-keeping program for the HC Band. To log in, follow these easy steps:

1. Go to www.charmsoffice.com (or click on the link on the HCHS band website top banner)
2. Enter hclayhsband under the pink "Parent/Student Login".
3. Enter your student's 6-digit birthday (mmddyy) as the Student ID/Password (you may change the password once inside the program).
