APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Parent meeting minutes from September 19th 2017 were approved as submitted with no questions, comments or concerns.

TREASURE'S REPORT: Ashley Critchley reported: No Changes in HCBB balance sheet. Balance sheet dated September 30, 2017 was provided. Money for band props and the color guard noted an increase in the budget this year. The check for stadium seating was received. We are ahead for collecting fees this year from band students we stand at 60% collected.

BINGO REPORT: Vonda Melton reported: We have \$20,496.00 in the Bingo account and she will be depositing \$5,000.00 to the main account to pay for upcoming rent money and taxes. She will also be working on the 3rd Q Bingo report with President Brian Rosenkrantz soon.

WAY AND MEANS: Debbie Stepter reported: The cookie dough fundraiser exceeded \$12,000.00 and the band approximately made \$4,000.000 from the fundraiser. The cookie dough fundraiser money was presented to Treasurer Ashley Critchley. Debbie will be following up with Penn Station and collecting fundraiser money from them.

Nick Sosby from snap-raise.com was introduced and pitched his fundraiser to the parents. The students are to provide twenty emails to snap-raise.com to raise money. The band will in turn will receive 70% or 77% of donations. Snap-raise and Director Mr. Bill Kite will process and monitor all contributes on behalf of HC. To receive 77% all students must participate by bringing 20 emails and raising at least \$10.00 otherwise the band will receive 70% of the money raised. The parents voiced concerns, asked questions and voted on this fundraiser. All were for the fundraiser meeting by a show of hands and none were opposed. Mr. Kite and Mrs. Stepter will be meeting with Mr. Sosby from snap-raise next Tuesday to work the details.

Vonda K Melton motioned for approval of snap-raise meeting next Tuesday and Kim Newton 2nd motion. All were in approval, no opposition was noted.

Brian Rosenkrantz announced we will be getting our check back from the YMCA at Dayton. The YMCA invited us back anytime.

STADIUM SEATING: Jennifer Baricklow reported: Approximately 3,533 seats were installed and she is anticipating 4,000 to 6,000 seats will need to be taken out on December 09th.
